

## **Application Notes**

Bafilomycin B1 shares the same mode of action and activity spectrum as its more accessible A1 analogue. Bafilomycin B1 is broadly active against bacteria, fungi, insects, nematodes and protozoans. It has attracted interest as a potential antiosteoporotic agent for the treatment of bone lytic diseases.
