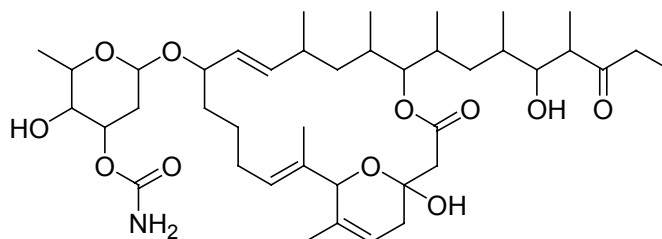

Application Notes

The macrolide antibiotic Venturicidin A, isolated from a *Streptomyces* sp., is a potent inhibitor of mitochondrial ATP synthase complex acting on the F₀ membrane sector. Venturicidin A was originally isolated as an antifungal agent.
